Hunt well and truly indebted toin the full and just sum of sixty two hundred fifty and no mos.Dollars, to be paid September 1st - 1919with interest thereon from date at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid annually ~~until paid in full~~ 10 per cent.until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, ~~and~~ note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10 per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

Mary that certain piece parcel, or tract of land situate lying and being in Hunt Township in the County of Greenville, in South Carolina, and about seven and one half miles from Greenville Court House South Carolina near Grove Creek waters of Saluda river, and having the following metes and bounds beginning at a stake at Mrs. Cleveland's corner of Grove Station road and running thence with said road N. 85 E. 14.00 to a iron bin on the edge of said road, thence N. 4 W. 22.00 to a stone, thence N. 85 W. 21.50 to a stone, thence S. 3 1/2 W. 9.60 to a stake; thence S. 15 1/4 E. 16.44 to the beginning corner, containing fifty (50) acres more or less and being the same tract of land conveyed to Elias Earle by W. F. Hunt and dated Dec- 7th- 1918 and being the same tract of land conveyed to W. L. Todd by T. F. Hunt by deed dated February 18th- 1919 to be recorded.
