extension of Gulliver Street east of Town of Fountain Inn, S.C. and containing nineteen
acres, more or less and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by Jas.M.Richardson
deed dated Jan 6th, 1919. Bounded by lands of Mrs. Joe Long, E.Lee Marlar, Graves Knight,
