Co., W.H.-Poole and lands formerly belonging to S.F. Trowbridge, and being the same lot of land conveyed to Mrs. J.B. Taylor by Henry P. McGee, by deed dated April 9th, 1918 and conveyed to me by Mrs. J.B. Taylor by deed of even date with this mortgage and not yet recorded.
