interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent on

amount besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note....., to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note....., reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

bargain, sell and release unto the said Eunice E. Sullivan

All that tract or parcel of land, situate lying and  
being in Greenville County, South Carolina, containing  
forty-six and one-third ( $46\frac{1}{3}$ ) acres, more or  
less, known as tract No. 8 in Sale of lands of Joseph  
W. Sullivan, having the following metes and bounds  
as appear by plat of Survey made by James J.  
Willie of date of April 1901, to wit: Beginning at  
a stone on a branch and running thence N. 29° E.  
3.43 to stone 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ; thence N. 41° W. 4.97 to stone 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ; thence  
N. 42 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 10.59 to stone 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ; thence N. 61° W. 12.00 to stone  
3 $\frac{1}{2}$  0m; thence N. 26° 6.00 to stone 3 $\frac{1}{2}$  0m; thence S.  
85° E. 18.50 to stone; thence S. 4° E. 11.72 to stone 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ;  
thence S. 45° W. 9.30 to a stone 3 $\frac{1}{2}$  0m branch; thence  
up said branch to the beginning corner.
