SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Charles W. Noble

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

L.O. Patterson, Trustee for R.H. & W.P. White

in the full and just sum of two hundred (\$200.00)

Dollars, to be paid on the eleventh day of October, A.D. 1921, with the privilege of paying the same or any part thereof on October 11th, 1919, or on October 11th, 1920.

with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

fifty dollars (\$50.00) besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to

the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Charles W. Noble

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

L.O. Patterson, Trustee as aforesaid

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

Chas. W. Noble

in hand well and truly paid by the said

L.O. Patterson, Trustee for R.H. & W.P. White

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said L.O. Patterson, Trustee for R.H. and W.P. White and his successors

in office, and assigns, all those two certain lots, pieces or parcels of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, a short distance west of the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, known and designated as lots numbered four (4) and five (5) in Block P., of a subdivision known as Park Place, according to a plat thereof recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances for said County and State in plat book A., at page 119; said lots having collectively, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake on the west side of Third Avenue one hundred and ninety (190) feet northward from a ten foot alley, and running thence along Third Avenue N. 0° 17' E. one hundred (100) feet to a stake on line of lot No. 6; thence along line of last mentioned lot S. 89° 45' W. one hundred and fifty (150) feet to a stake on said ten foot alley; thence along line of said alley S. 0° 17' W. about ninety-five (95) feet, more or less, to a stake at a bend in said alley; thence along said alley S. 34° 30' E. four (4) feet to a stake on corner of lot No. 3; thence along last mentioned lot N. 89° 45' E. one hundred and forty-eight (148) feet to the beginning corner; these being the same two lots conveyed to me, the said Charles W. Noble, by W.E. McCain by deed bearing date September 3, 1918 and recorded in said office on the day of its date in Deed Book 35, page 519. There is no other lien or encumbrance on said land by mortgage, judgment or otherwise.
