besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Farmers Loan and Trust Company, its

Successors and assigns forever. All that lot of land situate on the north side of Hampton Avenue, in the City and County of Greenville, and described as follows: Beginning at a point on said Hampton Avenue one hundred and fifteen and one half feet from the corner of said Avenue and Biggs Street, and run thence along said Avenue in an Easternly direction fifty-five (55) feet to the line of the Sumner lot; thence along the line of his lot one hundred and sixty-six (166) feet; thence in a Westernly direction in a line parallel with Hampton Avenue fifty five (55) feet; thence in a Southernly direction in a line parallel with the line of the Sumner lot, one hundred and sixty-six (166) feet to the point of beginning on Hampton Avenue.
