with interest thereon from at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jas M Richardson

All that certain piece parcel and tract of land lying and being situate in the County and State aforesaid, containing twenty four acres, more or less, and being the same lands conveyed to me by julia P. Richardson of the said lands lying on the West side of the Concord Road, near White Church, and about fifteen miles North of the City of Greenville, bounded by lands of Mr. Lackey, Mr. Stanley, the Concord Road, the Dickens Road and others, reference being made to the said deed from Mrs. Richardson to W. R. Fowler for a fuller description of lands.

Also all that certain piece parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County and State of South Carolina and in Saluda Township, with the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stone and running N. 10° 45' 18.80 to a stone; thence N. 75° 46.55E to old road bend; thence S. 88° 16.42S to bend; thence N. 80° 15.25E to iron pin; thence N. 31° 26.22W to iron pin; thence N. 82° 12.74E to the beginning corner, containing twenty-five acres, more or less, and bounded by lands of B. E. Dossell, Mrs. Sion Batson, N. C. Bailey and others, the same being a portion of a tract of land conveyed to N. C. Bailey by Eli Whit Bailey, being dated December 9th, 1908. The above tracts of land being the same conveyed to me by julia P. Richardson by deed dated June 10th, 1912.
