All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being on the west side of Buncome Street, in Ward 1 of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds to wit: commencing at an iron pipe on the west side of Buncome Street 11 feet S.E. of Dr. Stone property, corner of J.D. Gilreath property; thence S. 56° 06' W. 131.5 feet to an iron pipe; thence along line of Gilreath property S. 39° 46' E. 105 feet to an iron pipe; thence continuing with same property S. 48° 30' W. 55.6 feet to a point on a 12 foot alley; thence along the east side of said alley S. 69° 32' E. 267 feet to an iron pipe, corner of property of J.
