interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *One percent*

This Mortgage is dated Jan 1921 besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note to be collectible as debt thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by the proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had as will more fully appear.

bargain, sell and release unto the said *John W. Richardson, Attorney*

All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying,
and being situated in the County and State aforesaid,
near the City of Greenville and in a Sub-division
known as Morgan Hill, known and designated upon
a plat of said Morgan Hill as lot No. 103, said lot
being recorded in the office of A. J. C. for Greenville
County in Plat Book A at page 76, reference thereto
being made. Said lot begins on Parker Avenue
56 feet from Morgan Hill property, and runs
thence back along line of lot No. 104, 199.2 feet;
thence S. 12-30 E. 62 feet to lot 102; thence along lot
No. 102 198.3 feet to Parker Avenue; thence along said
Avenue 56 feet to beginning corner, this being the
same lot of land conveyed to me by A. A. Leonard on
May 19th, 1916, said deed being recorded in the office
of A. J. C. for Greenville County in Book 39 at page 356.
Also all that other piece, parcel and lot of land adjoining
the above described lot, and known and designated
as lot No. 104 in the Sub-division of the said Morgan
Hill. This said lot begins on Morgan Hill property
at Parker Avenue, and runs thence back along the
Morgan Hill property two hundred feet, thence
S. 12-30 E. 62 feet to lot No. 103; thence back toward
Parker Avenue along lot No. 103 199.2 feet to said
avenue; thence along Parker Avenue 56 feet to
beginning corner, and being the same lot of land
conveyed to me by Mrs. W. L. and W. L. Burden by
their deed dated November 24th, 1908, and recorded
in the office of A. J. C. for Greenville County in
Book 11, page 363.
