SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, J. D. H. McDaniel (unmarried man) in and by my certain note in writing, of even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to

L. D. Patterson, Attorney in the full and just sum of twelve hundred dollars (\$1200.00)

Dollars, to be paid on the twenty second day of November, A. D. 1923, with the privilege of paying the same in full prior to the year 1923, on condition that notice of such such payment with interest thereon from this date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid

until paid in full, interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney of law to be appointed, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That J. D. H. McDaniel in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said L. D. Patterson, Attorney

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to J. D. H. McDaniel in hand well and truly paid by the said L. D. Patterson, Attorney

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said L. D. Patterson, Attorney and his assigns

in office and assignee, all that certain piece parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, in Batee Township, on Reedy River and on the Mucklehoney Road to Travelers Rest, known and designated as Lot No. 3 of the F. M. Edwards farm, on a plat thereof made by Will D. Greer dated November 21, 1913, and having according to such plat, the following meter and bounds to-wit: Beginning at a stone on the north-west corner of Lot No. 2, now the land of said J. D. H. McDaniel, and running thence along line of land of Hawkins or Hudgins, or both S. 63° 55' W. 8.55 chains to a stone on the north-east corner of Lot No. 4; thence S. 26° E. 43.40 chains along line of Lot No. 4; to a stake in Mucklehoney Road; thence S. 0° 45' W. 2.95 chains to a stake; thence S. 42° 30' E. 3.50 chains to a stake; thence S. 44° 30' W. 50 links to a stake on said road and on Reedy River; thence down said river S. 21° E. 5.50 chs. to a stake on said River; thence N. 58° 15' E. about 72 links to a stake; thence S. 32° E. 1.12 chains to a stake; thence N. 37° 30' E. 2.88 chs. to a stake; thence N. 26° 15' W. 4.00 chains to a stake; thence N. 63° 55' E. 5.64 chs. to a stake on the south-west corner of Lot No. 2; thence N. 25° W. 50.80 chs. along line of Lot No. 2, now land of said J. D. H. McDaniel, to the beginning corner, containing forty-two and nine-tenths (42.9) acres, more or less.
