with interest thereon from the 24th day of Sept 1919 at the rate of seven (7%) per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid as above

paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of five (5%) per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said W. A. Henderson

The two tracts of land, described as follows:  
(1) All that piece, parcel or tract of land lying  
-being and situate in Greenville County, State aforesaid  
said containing fifty-five and 7/100 (55 7/10) acres  
more or less, and being the same tract of land  
this day conveyed to me by deed of J. M. Henderson  
and known as the J. M. Henderson tract and a small  
portion of the J. F. Fowler tract.  
(2) Also all that other piece parcel or tract of land  
situate lying and being in Greenville County, State  
of South Carolina, containing twenty-three and one  
third (23 1/3) acres, more or less and known as the  
remainder of the tract of land conveyed to J. M.  
Henderson by deed of J. M. Hammond and this  
day conveyed to me by deed of J. M. Henderson  
said deed to be recorded, reference being made
