I, J.T. Gillespie of the County and State aforesaid SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said J.T. Gillespie  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

John A. Park

in the full and just sum of Three thousand  
Dollars, to be paid one year from the date hereof

with interest thereon from this 19<sup>th</sup> day of April 1920  
computed and paid annually John A. Park at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent of amount due besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said J.T. Gillespie  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

John A. Park

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

J.T. Gillespie

in hand well and truly paid by the said

John A. Park

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said John A. Park, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land

situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid:  
Commencing at a stake on Park Avenue (formerly Carrier Street), and running along said  
Avenue N. 76-1/2 W. seventy-eight (78) feet and eight (8) inches to a stake corner of alley;  
thence along said alley N. 13-1/2 E. eighty-five (85) feet to a stake corner of Ava O.-  
Ferguson's line; thence along said Ferguson's line S. 76-1/2 E. seventy-eight (78) feet  
and eight (8) inches to a stake on John F. Mitchells line; thence with said line S. 13-1/2  
W. eighty-five (85) feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot of land conveyed  
to me by L.H. Chewning by deed dated April 15th, 1919 and not yet recorded.  
Also all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the State  
and County aforesaid, and containing fifty (50) feet by one hundred (100) feet, bounded  
by lands of Southern Railway, Dr. R.D. Smith and J.T. Gillespie, and Beginning at  
Smiths line and running West fifty (50) feet; thence South one hundred (100) feet; thence  
East fifty (50) feet; thence North one hundred (100) feet; this being a portion of the  
land bought by J.T. Gillespie from the heirs of J.D. Gillespie, deed being recorded in  
Book 3, page 36, in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C.
