with interest thereon from December 1st 1917 at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid quarterly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest for any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten percent of amount
due thereon besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

bargain, sell and release unto the said Judson Mills

frontage on Piedmont Avenue of 60' 0" and a depth
of 150' 0" to the 100' Right of Way of the Piedmont & North
