SEND GREETING:

WHERERAS,

in and by 2 certain July 1919 of the said J. J. A. Foster  
even date with these presents, Bank of Greenville and W. F. Foster  
in the full and just sum of Three Thousand Dollars Fourteen 24/100  
Dollars, to be paid Pass. 1st. 1929

with interest thereon from July 1st 1919 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid quarterly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Fifteen per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said Farmers Bank of Simpsonville, its Successors

and assign: all those two certain lots of land situated  
lying and being in the town of Simpsonville County &  
State aforesaid and described as follows: 1st. Lot beginning  
at a point on Cox Street and running thence  
with said street N. 75 E. 60 feet to the corner of lot #30,  
thence along the line of this lot S. 15-15 E. 14 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet  
to a stake, thence S. 75-30 W. 60 feet (incorrectly written  
N. 75-30 E. in Deed) thence N. 15-15 W. 14 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet to the  
beginning corner, said being lot #31 on a plat called  
"Hill Crest" made by Will D. Nease.

2nd. Lot, Beginning at a point on Cox Street and  
running thence with this street N. 75 E. 60 ft. to a  
stake and thence S. 15-15 14 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet to a stake; thence  
S. 75-30 W. 60 feet to a stake, thence N. 15-15 W. 140 feet  
to the beginning corner, same being lot #33 of a  
plat of land called "Hill Crest" made by Will D. Nease.  
First lot being same conveyed to me by W. F. Foster  
by deed dated Feb. 12th. 1916 and recorded in  
office of R.M.C. for Greenville in Vol. 39 at page  
113 and second lot being same conveyed to me  
by Perpetual Building & Loan Association by deed  
dated June 2nd. 1919 & not yet recorded + also  
conveyed to said Perpetual Building & Loan  
Association by W. F. Foster by deed dated Nov. 6th.  
1916 and recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville  
in Vol. 41 at page 308.
