computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent of the
amount due thereon besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

limits of the City of Greenville, and being known
and designated as Lot No. 10, Block "L" on plat
of property of O. C. Mills, deceased, said plat
being recorded in the office of the Register of
Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Plat
Book "C" at page 146.

Said lot has the following, described meter and
bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on
Prentiss Avenue, corner of Lot No. 11; thence S.
44.33 E. one hundred and eighty (180) feet to an
iron pin; thence S. 45.27 W. sixty-three (63) feet to
an iron pin, corner of lot No. 9; thence along
line of Lot No. 9 N. 44.33 W. one hundred and eighty
feet (180) to an iron pin on said Prentiss Avenue,
