interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Five Hundred Dollars

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings, of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference

bargain, sell and release unto the said Sarah B. Pol

all that certain lot or parcel of land situate lying
and being within the City of Greenville, County
and State aforesaid, on the South side of Buncombe
Street, and having the following metes and bounds:
Beginning at an iron pin one hundred forty-three feet
and eleven inches (143.11) from the Southeast corner
of Buncombe and Whitner Street, and running in
a South westerly direction seventy-two feet (72)
to an iron pin, thence along a line parallel to
Whitner Street, in a South westerly direction seventy-
four feet and two inches (74.2) to a stake, thence in
a South easterly direction along the Loller lot sixty-
three feet (63) to a stake on a line of a lot now
or formerly owned by A. H. Wells, thence with line
at said lot in a North easterly direction one
hundred fifty (150) feet to Buncombe Street, thence
in a North westerly direction with Buncombe
Street fifty-two feet and eleven inches (52.11) to
