WHEREAS, I, Mary Mauldin Miller in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, now well and truly indebted to

Susan C. Miller in the full and just sum of Fourteen Hundred and fifty Dollars Dollars, to be paid on or before July 1st 1922

with interest thereon from this 21 day of Nov. 1921 at the rate of ten per cent. per annum to be computed and paid

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as above; and any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten percent of the amount due thereon, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Mary Mauldin Miller in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mortgagee

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to Mortgagee in hand well and truly paid by the said Mortgagee

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mortgagee and her heirs and assigns,

forever, all and singular that certain piece, parcel lot or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State aforesaid, near the incorporate limits of the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot 410.10 of Block E 2 of property of O. P. Miller, deceased, as shown on plat of said property recorded in the Register of Deeds Conveyance Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C" at page 176. Said lot has the following described metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin corner of Prentiss Avenue and Labson Street, thence N. 44.33 W. One hundred and eighty feet to an alley; thence with said alley N. 45.27 E. sixty five feet to an iron pin corner of lot 410.8; thence along line of lot 410.8 S. 44.33 E. One hundred and eighty feet to an iron pin on said Prentiss Avenue; thence with said Prentiss Avenue S. 45.27 W. Sixty-five feet to the beginning.
