interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of reasonable fee

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said J. B. Wiley, his heirs and assigns all

that piece parcel and lot of land situate lying and
being in Greenville Co., Greenville County and State, South Carolina
beginning at an iron pin at corner of Howell land,
thence N 77 1/2 W 55 feet to Stake on Howell line; thence
S 12 1/2 W 105 feet to a stake on line of lot owned by Laura
C. Johnson 105 from parkin Street S 77 1/2 W 55 feet to
the beginning corner. One eighth of an acre, more
or less being the same lot of land conveyed to me
this day by said J. B. Wiley.
