bargain, sell and release unto the said J. R. Gallivan

all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate
lying and being in the City of Greenville, County
and State aforesaid, and on the east side of McCall
Street, having a frontage of fifty-four (54) feet on
said McCall Street and running back in parallel
lines at right angles with McCall Street a distance
of one hundred and Seventy-five (175) feet to McCall
Street, and along said alley in a line equal in
length, and parallel with the line on McCall Street,
and being lot No. 3 on a plat recorded in Plat Book
A page 158 in the R.M.C. Office for said Greenville
County, which plat represents a division of
lots Nos. 35, 36 and 37 of the T.E. Ware property; and
being the same lot of land conveyed to me, the
said J. R. Gedens, by Mary Ellen Johnson by deed
dated August 31st A.D. 1918, and recorded in said
Register's office in Vol. 42 at page 495 also all that other
piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the City
of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and in Ward Six of said
City, having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at
an iron pipe, corner of Thruxton and Howe Streets, one block
east of Augusta Street and running thence with Thruxton Street
S. 65-25' W. one hundred and thirty-nine and two-tenths (139.2) feet to
an iron pipe, thence S. 23-95' E. two hundred and seven and one tenth
(207.1) feet to an iron pipe, thence with line of Thruxton property
N. 64-30' E. one hundred and thirty-nine and six-tenths (139.6)
feet to Howe Street (formerly Roma Street), thence with Howe
Street N. 23-15' W. two hundred and five (205) feet to the beginning
