All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying
and being in the City of Greenville, County and
State aforesaid, being known and designated as
lot 410.4 on a plat of land known as Younce Street
property, said plat made by Wm. D. Nevel, C. E. October
1909, and recorded in the W.M.C. office for Greenville
County S.C. in plat book of Cleveland & Willman
and having according to said plat, the following
metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an
iron pin on the West side of Younce Street,
joint corner of lot 410.3 and 4, and running
thence along the line of lot 410.3 N. 46 W. 200 feet to
an iron pin on a fourteen foot alley; thence along
the line of said alley 26.14 E. 60 feet and 5 inches to
an iron pin, joint corner of lot 410.4 and 5; thence
