SEND GREETING:

Dollars, to be paid January 1st, 1920

with interest thereon from maturity at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid Annually

until paid in full; an interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
due thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10%

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
