WHEREAS, I W. G. Wallace of the County and State

in the full and just sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-two and 50/100 (\$1,592.50)
Dollars, to be paid One year after date with the right to anticipate at
any time before maturity

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 6 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid as this is by

This Money is Satisfied in Full
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent (10%)

Wm G. Serrine besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I W. G. Wallace
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Wm G. Serrine
and W. D. Workman according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

W. G. Wallace in hand well and truly paid by the said Wm G. Serrine and W. D. Workman

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said Wm G. Serrine and W. D. Workman, their heirs

And assigns forever, all that lot piece or parcel of land situate
lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State
aforesaid, on Pendleton and Augusta Streets and having the
following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on Pendleton Street corner of lot
now owned by American Bank; thence along line of American
Bank 80.30 E. ninety three (93) feet to an iron pin on Augusta
Street; thence with Augusta Street in a S.W. Direction twenty-five (25) feet to an iron pin corner of upper lot conveyed by
James E. Payne to us on June 28th, 1919 and recorded in R. M. C.
Office for Greenville County in Vol 54 page 70; thence with
with line of said lot to an iron pin on Pendleton Street; thence
with Pendleton Street in a N.E. Direction twenty-five (25) feet
to beginning corner. Being the same lot of land conveyed to us
by James E. Payne by deed dated June 28th, 1919 and recorded
in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 54 page 69.

This mortgage is given to secure the credit portion of the
