THIS INDENTURE, made this 12th, day of August A. D. 1918
by and between J.E. Bryson

party of the first part, and the MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, of Greenville, S. C., a corporation, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Eighteen hundred

Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to discharge

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

All that lot of land situate on the north side of Arlington Avenue (formerly Garlington Street) in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina; Beginning at an iron pin on Arlington Avenue at the corner of the Nannie A. Ellison lot; thence with the line of that lot N. 27 E. one hundred and fourteen feet and five inches to an iron pin; thence S. 71-3/4 E. thirty three feet and seven and one-half inches to a stake; thence S. 28-3/4 W. one hundred and sixteen feet to a stake on Arlington Avenue; thence with Arlington Avenue N. 69 W. thirty feet to the beginning corner, being the land conveyed to me by A.B. Gardner by deed dated the day of August, and not yet recorded.
