WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Two thousand Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

Beginning on the south side of East Avenue, at a stake corner of lot No. 7; thence along line of that lot S. 13.45 E. 204.5 feet to a stake; thence N. 76.15 E. 64 feet to a stake; thence N. 13.45 W. 201 feet to a stake on said East Avenue; thence along said Ave. 64 feet to the beginning corner, being known and designated as lot No. 8 on plat of the Jones Place, and conveyed to me by Amanda E. Robinson, by deed dated the 27th, of March 1918 and recorded in Vol. page 207.
