WITNESSETH Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said Home BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Four Thousand (\$4,000.00)

Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of six per cent. per annum, payable

the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the Fourth ward of the City of Greenville having the following metes and bounds, to-wit, Beginning at a stake on the South side of East Washington Street on the corner of another lot of land which now belongs to the said R. J. Woodside, and which formerly belonged to Alex Finlay, and running thence along line of the last mentioned lot in a southerly direction, approximately parallel with Mordecai Street, one hundred and fifty three (153) feet to an iron pin on corner of No. 26 Kilgus's lot; thence with line of last mentioned lot in an easterly direction, parallel with Washington Street, fifty (50) feet toward Heldman Street, to an iron pin at corner of the Kuffie lot; thence in a northerly direction along the Kuffie line, parallel with the line of the Alex. Finlay lot first above referred to, one hundred and fifty three (153) feet to an iron pin on Washington Street, thence along Washington Street in a westerly direction fifty (50) feet to the beginning corner; containing 7650 square feet more or less, and being the same lot of land that was conveyed to me, the said Robert J. Woodside, by Mrs. Julia M. Kennedy; this being a first mortgage on said land and being given to secure the payment of a portion of the purchase money therefor. The deed by the said Julia M. Kennedy conveying said lot to me bears date the - day of April, 1919.
