THIS INDENTURE, made this 24th day of May A. D. 1919
by and between B. A. Butler

WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of nine hundred 900⁰⁰ Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of six eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

"All that piece, parcel, or lot of land situated in Ward 5 of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on the West side of Mallard Street, being known as lot No. 4 of a subdivision in R. M. C. of the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being a subdivision of the lands of the Grantors of the said lot having the following dimensions and bounds, beginning at an iron pipe on the West side of Mallard Street (This point being the South East corner of lot No. 3, of the plat above referred to and running thence S. 21.44 N. 61 feet along the West side of Mallard Street, to an iron pin at corner of lot No. 5; thence along line of last mentioned lot N. 87.6.21 W. 169.7 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 18.39 E. 60.6 feet to an iron pin at corner of lot No. 3, thence along the line of last mentioned lot S. 76.21 E. 173 feet to the beginning corner on Mallard Street."
