WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Two Thousand (\$2000.00)

Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of six eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situated, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and known and designated as lot #1 in survey and plat of the Venus lands made by W. A. Hudson D.S. in 1904, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin at the intersection of Buncombe Road and Venus Street, and running thence along Venus Street S. 78 N. 203 feet to an iron pin thence N. 13 1/2 E. 66 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 78 E. 203 feet to an iron pin, on the Buncombe Road thence along said Buncombe Road S. 13 1/2 N. 66 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Jno. T. Buff by deed dated the - day of May 1919.

Also all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated lying and being in the County of Greenville State of South Carolina near the incorporate limits of the City of Greenville, having a frontage on Heyward Street of sixty feet and a depth of one hundred and fifty feet, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by S. C. Gentry by deed dated May 31st 1917.
