by and between J. E. Brunson

WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Forty-five hundred Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is assigned to secure.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the south side of Elkin street in the city and county of Greenville S. C. at corner of the Whitnair lot; thence runs along Elkin street N. 80.45 W. fifty feet to corner of the M. Howard lot; thence with the line of that lot S. 0.30 E. one hundred ninety to feet to corner on Harris line; thence with that line N. 67 E. fifty-three and one-half feet to Whitnair's corner; thence with that line W. 0.30 W. one hundred and sixty-three feet to the beginning being the same land conveyed to one Mrs. W. D. Workman, deed not yet recorded.
