WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS PERPETUAL BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure.

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Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

In Greenville Township, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a stake on the Northwest Corner of Carl and Robinson Street and running thence with Carl Street S. 83-13 C. 108 feet and 9 inches, thence parallel with Robinson Street N. 1-41 E. 200 feet to a 16 foot alley; thence with said alley N. 83-13 W. 108 feet and 9 inches to Robinson Street; thence with Robinson Street S. 1-41 W. 200 feet to beginning, being lot no. 26 of section "C", on plat of Stone land, recorded in Plat book A, Page 337 to 345 R. M. C. Office for said county, being the same conveyed to me by J. J. Westervelt, deed dated May 17 1919, recorded in Book 56, Page 512.
