the City of Greenville, on the northwest corner of the Buncombe Road and Brockman Avenue; beginning at a stake on the Buncombe Road and running thence N. 54-25. W. 225 feet to stake; thence N. 16-30 E. 93 feet one inch to stake; thence S. 54-25 E. 225 feet to stake on Brockman Avenue; thence N. 16-30 W. to the beginning corner, being more fully described as lot No. 10 Block A out plat of Suburban Land Company and known as Lane Louci Villa.
