Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

first outside the limits of the City of Greenville, near Lincoln Street, on the east side of Montgomery Avenue Beginning at corner of N. D. Smith and, running eastwardly along said line 100 feet, thence easterly with Montgomery Avenue to a point midway to south line of Hulda A. Southwood and David J. Southwood, thence with said southerly line to a point on Montgomery Avenue which is 53 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet from the beginning, thence along Montgomery Avenue 53 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to the beginning corner.
