released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Norwood National Bank

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 12 2/3 acres, more or less, known

as the McBrayer place, being all of the McBrayer place,
formerly acquired by me and more fully described in
deeds to me from W. A. McBrayer and from J. A. McLoubray
and B. M. Blythe, recorded in N. S. C. office for
Greenville County in Book 19, at page 93, and in same
book at page 384, and also more fully described in
mortgage recorded in said office in book 54, at
page 254, now to be satisfied, saving and excepting
ten acres conveyed by me to Carolina Phosphate
Company, described in deed recorded in said
