all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in **Greenville**

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, **in Ward Four, of Greenville, City on the East side of**

South Main Street, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the East side of South Main Street fifty-five (55) feet from the southeast corner of said Street and McBee Avenue, at the center of a seventeen (17) inch brick wall, and running thence with South Main Street South 20-39 West forty-six (46) feet, one-half (1/2) inch to corner of D.D. Davenport's lot; thence South 69-57 East one hundred forty-three (143) feet, one (1) inch to a laundry wall on lot C; thence North 20-00 East forty-six (46) feet, two (2) inches to the Northeast corner of lot B; thence North 70-01 West one hundred forty-two (142) feet six (6) inches to beginning corner on Main Street (the last mentioned line, for a portion of the distance, running through the center of said Seventeen (17) inch brick wall), being known as lot B., of the Sue Harris Earle property, according to plat made by R.E.
