NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said R. L. Campbell, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Frank A. Mitchell, his heirs and assigns all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in the township of

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing fifty-four and three-fourths ($54\frac{3}{4}$) acres, more or less, as represented by plat of W. L. Mitchell, Surveyor, dated February 10, 1919, being a portion of the Rev. A. G. Stephenson tract and described as follows: Beginning at a corner W. 7.2 Ridgebridge land on a public road, running thence N. 68 E. 19.92 to a stone; thence N. 65 $\frac{1}{3}$ E. 18.04 to a stake on branch; thence N. 5 $\frac{1}{3}$, N. 3.87 to a corner on branch; thence N. 35 W. 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ to a corner; thence S. 19.9 N. 31 to a corner, stake; thence S. 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 18.05 to a corner on road aforesaid; thence S. 72 $\frac{1}{3}$ E. 41 to the beginning corner; a tract of land 14.24 acres (fourteen hundred twenty-four) more or less, conveyed to B. F. Martin by J. A. McCallough.
