in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do give, bargain, sell and release unto the said

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Ward one of the City of Greenville: Beginning at a

rock corner on the east side of Townes Street 164 feet from the southeast corner of Townes Street and Stone Avenue, and running thence S. 84-1/2 E. 179 feet to a stake, corner of the fence of H.J. Haynsworth; thence with fence of H.J. Haynsworth S. 19 W. 162 feet, more or less, to line of C.B. Martin; thence with line of C.B. Martin N. 71 W. 173 feet to stake on Townes Street; thence with Townes Street N. 20 E. 122 feet to the beginning corner.
