 promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note.....be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of
 any kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I.....

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the
 payment thereof according to the terms of the said note.....and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me.....
 in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and
 released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *C. T. Dill*

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in *Greenville*,
 Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, *just outside the corporate limits*

 of the City of Greenville, on the north side of Perry
 Avenue, beginning at an iron pin on said Perry
 Avenue and running thence N. 21-59 E. 220.2 feet
 to an iron pin on Dale Street; thence N. 66-58 W. 161
 feet with Dale Street to an iron pin; thence S.
 20-33 W. 116.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 71-0 E. 55
 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 20-33 W. 115 feet to
 Perry Avenue; thence with Perry Avenue S. 01-0 E.
 100.4 feet to the beginning corner, this being the
