 day of *June*, 19*20*

.....with interest from *date*
 at the rate of *Seven*.....per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid.....*K*.....annually,

and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I.....have further
 promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note.....be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of
 any kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I.....*Shade H Green*

.....in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the
 payment thereof according to the terms of the said note.....and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me.....

in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and
 released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Elijaheth S Beaty*

.....all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in *Batesville*,
 Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

My land due of the *This Mortgage satisfied in full* day of *January* 19*20*,
 being part of the *Shade H Green* tract of land in *Batesville*, on the west side of
 Rutherford Street, beginning at a point on Rutherford Street,
 corner of an alley, shade *green* thence with Rutherford
 Street, S. 45° 15' E. 50 feet to a stake, corner of lot occupied by a
 Batson: thence with Batson's line S 45° 15' 20.131 feet, more
 or less, to fence post; thence with fence N. 11° 38'. 51.2 feet,
 more or less, to fence post its line of property of Mary
 Elta Walker, et al thence with said Walker line N. 49° 05'
 E. 2.3.8 feet, more or less, to stake corner of alley, thence with
 alley N. 78° 44' E. 16.3 feet, more or less, to point on Rutherford
 Street, the beginning corner, being the same conveyed to
 me by *Elijaheth S Beaty* my deed dated May 10, 1917, and rec-

 dated January 23, 1908 and recorded in Book 26, page 268.
