promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note.....be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of
any kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I.....the said.....Marcie Jackson

.....in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the
payment hereof according to the terms of the said note.....and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me.....

in hand well and truly paid.....and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said.....H R Townes

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

Beginning on the north side of Cox
Bridge Road adjoining lands of Den Mills, Baynesworth, Eddie
Floyd. Beginning at an iron pin corner of Den Mills
land runs N. 15 E. 129' thence S 75 1/2 W 33' to a maple tree;
thence S 7 1/2 E 85' to iron pin; thence S 5 1/2 E 520'
thence N. 74 E 60' to the beginning, containing 10 acres, more
or less. Also ~~two~~ two certain pieces, parcels or lots of land
situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina,
County and Township of Greenville on the south side of the
Southern Railway two and one half miles from Greenville
Court House in a section known as Fleetown near the Brandon
Mills and having the following metes and bounds according
