all that certain piece parcel and lot of land situate,
 lying and being in Greenville, County in the State
 of South Carolina, and hath the following course,
 metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a large
 black iron on the north side of the Eliza Ballenger
 spring branch and run thence N. 30° W. 4.00 chs. to
 a head in an old road, thence N. 29° W. 9.53 chs. to
 a stake at the intersection of the old road with
 the new road, S. D. Moesteller corner, thence with
 his line about S. 64 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 5.50 chs. to a stake N. M.; thence
 S. 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° W. 23.68 chs. to a stake in the road N. M.; thence
