all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville on

the West side of Brier Street and having the following  
metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake on Brier St.  
Pointe Person's lot (now owned by B. G. Geer); thence with  
said Person's lot, 46. Sixty-Five (65) feet to a stake corner  
Mortgage Lot; Land and Improvement lot (now  
owned by Thomas Geer) joined with said Company's  
line and hundred (100) feet stake on corner alley  
known as Carson Street; thence with said alley 65  
feet to a stake corner Brier St. and
