in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

M.A. Merritt, his heirs and assigns that certain lot of land situate in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, aforesaid, on the east side of

North Main Street, having a frontage of seventy (70) feet, more or less, on said street, and a depth of two hundred ten (210) feet, more or less, bounded on the north by lot of Edith S. Wleton and on the south by George F. Bryan, and being the same lot conveyed to me by C. Luman, Master, by deed dated the 24th July, 1919, recorded in the R. M. C. Office in said County, in Vol. 40, at page 88.
