Personally comes before me, C. C. Hindman, who being duly sworn says: on January 3, 1920, I obtained deed from J. P. Ables to a tract of land, 48.4 acres more or less in this county as shown in Deed Book 66 at page 265; there was a mortgage of record from J. P. Ables to B. O. Bentley for Three Thousand (\$3000.00) Dollars on said land dated October 28, 1919, recorded in office of P. M.
