have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Bank of Commerce, its successors and assigns

iron pin on the north side of East Stone Ave.
at a point 54 1/2 feet west of Bennett Street, and
runs thence n. 17 E. 206 1/2 feet to an iron pin;

S. 17 W. 206 1/2 feet to an iron pin on Stone Ave.
thence with said Ave. S. 73 E. 54 1/2 feet to the beginning
