Warren Lipscombe, all that piece parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the state and County aforesaid, in Greenville Township, Sans Souci Villa, being a subdivision of the Suburban Land Company plat which is of record in the R. F. C. office for Greenville County, said lot having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on East side of Brockman Avenue at a point fifty-two and 1/10 feet south of northern line of lot no. 34 and running thence S. 57° 25' E. 175 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 10° 30' W. 62 1/10 feet to an iron pin at T. M. Taylor's corner, thence along said Taylor's line N. 57° 25' W. 175 feet to an iron pin on Brockman Avenue, thence with said Brockman Avenue N. 10° 30' E. 62 1/10 feet to the beginning corner. Said lot being composed of 31 feet to lot, no. 34 and 31 1/10 feet of lot no. 33 of Sans Souci Villa, as per plat of same. This being the same lot of which was conveyed to me by R. L. Keeler by deed dated August 23, 1919, and recorded in R. F. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Book 57 page 29. This lot is subject to certain restrictions as set forth in deed from Suburban Land Co.

Also all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville township, Greenville County, state of South Carolina, just outside the corporate limits of the city of Greenville, beginning at a stake corner of Robinson Street and Mountain View Avenue and running thence in an easterly direction seventy-five feet to a stake corner of lots nos. 1 and 2 on plat hereinafter referred to; thence in a southerly direction with line of lot no. 2 one hundred seventy feet and six inches to stake corner of an alley; thence with said alley one hundred thirty-six feet and six inches to stake corner of said alley and Robinson Street; thence with Robinson Street in a northwesterly direction one hundred eighty feet to a stake at the beginning corner, being known as lot no. 1 in block 13 of the subdivision of the Burts property, known as Oakland Heights mapped by W. D. Nease June 1st 1911.
