All that certain piece parcel or lot of land, situate in and lying in the Butler Township aforesaid County and State, on the Waters of Brushy Creek, waters of Enoree river and having the following meters and bounds to-wit:  
Beginning at a rock 3X; thence N. 79 1/2 E. 28.62 to stake; thence N. 5 E. 12.43 to a rock on Bigham Branch; thence down said branch to a stake on Brushy Creek; thence up said creek 7.93 to a maple; thence N. 32 3/4 W. 9.17 to a rock 3X; thence S. 15 W. 15.67 to an iron pin; thence S. 28 W. 17.70 to a rock 3X; thence S. 50 1/2 W. 3.70 to a pine; thence S. 30 3/4 W. 20.80 to the beginning corner, containing twenty-four and 27 one hundredths (24.27) acres, more or less according to a plat made by James P.
