All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land containing three and 7/10 (3 7/10) acres more or less, situated, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, about three miles from Greenville Court House adjoining lands of Croft, Bradley, Green and Jenkins: Beginning on a Red oak stump and running thence S. 48 1/2 E. 5.25 to a stone on old line; thence N. 8 1/2 E. 5.46 to a stone in old road; thence with said road N. 73 1/2 W. 18 to a stone on the road; thence S. 8 1/2 E. 6.50 to the beginning corner.
