Beginning at an iron pin on corner and running thence with Mills Avenue S. 54-06 W. 150 feet to iron pipe, corner of lot Seven; thence with line of lot seven S. 29-02 W. 63 feet to iron pipe on Augusta Street; thence with Augusta Street N. 29-02 W. 63 feet to the beginning corner.
