Virginia, in one, two, three, four and five years respectively; that is to say \$200.00 March 3rd, 1922; \$200.00 March 3rd, 1923; \$200.00, March 3rd, 1924; \$200.00 March 3rd, 1925 and \$200.00 March 3rd, 1926, all in gold coin of the United States of America, of present standard of weight and fineness, each of said notes bearing interest from maturity until paid at the rate of seven and one-half per cent per annum, payable semi-annually; semi-annual interest notes covering all interest on said principal as they become due semi-annually having been at the same time executed, said interest notes being reduced in amount in proportion each year as the said principal notes mature and are paid; said principal notes provide if principal or interest is not paid when due, whole to become due at option of holder.
