SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS the said *Annice W. Earle* indebted in and by *me* certain notes bearing date the *Seventh* day of *March* A. D. 1923

for the principal sum of *Four Thousand* Dollars, payable to the order of THE LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY OF VIRGINIA, a Corporation duly chartered under the laws of Virginia,

at the home office of said Company, Richmond, Virginia, in one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten, eleven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, nineteen, twenty, twenty one, twenty two, twenty three, twenty four, twenty five, twenty six, twenty seven, twenty eight, twenty nine, and thirty years, that is to say, \$200.00 Mar. 19, 1924; \$200.00 Mar. 19, 1925; \$200.00 Mar. 19, 1926; \$200.00 Mar. 19, 1927; and \$220.00 Mar. 19, 1928, all in full gain of the United States of America, of which said *Annice W. Earle* is a citizen, each of said notes bearing interest at the rate of six per cent. per annum, or payable semi-annually, semi-annual interest notes covering all interest on said principal notes as they become due and semi-annually having been at the same time executed, said interest notes being reduced in amount in proportion each year as the said principal notes mature and are paid, said principal notes provide if principal or interest is not paid when due, to become due at the option of holder.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the said *Annice W. Earle*

in consideration of the said Debt and Notes aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, and the performance of the covenants herein contained, to the said The Life Insurance Company of Virginia, according to the condition of the said Notes, and also in consideration of the further sum of one dollar to *me*

the said *Annice W. Earle* in hand well and truly paid by the said Company at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed, confirmed, released and by these Presents do grant, bargain and sell and release unto the said The Life Insurance Company of Virginia, its successors and assigns

*Beginning at a point on the northeast corner of lot 70, 71 and runs thence with the line of said lot 70, 71 and 72 to corner lot 75, thence with the line of that lot S. 25. 22 E. 286.4 feet to joint corner with lot 74, 75, 76 and 77, thence with line of lot 7. S. 5 1/2 E. 117.9 feet to joint corner of lots 76, 77, 78 and 79, thence along the line of lot 79, 1500 feet to the beginning corner. Being lot 77 as shown by plat recorded in Plat Book E, page 270, the above land being situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina.*
