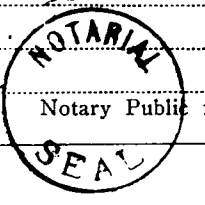

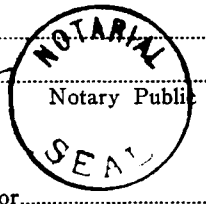
RENUNCIATION OF DOWER.
